

#### DALLAS ARBORETUM AND BOTANICAL GARDENS

Experience scenic views and vibrant floral landscapes at this 66-acre display garden. Named "One of the Most Breathtaking Gardens in the World" by *Architectural Digest*, the Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Gardens will connect you with nature and teach you about life and science.

**DALLAS ARTS DISTRICT** – The Dallas Arts District is home to a variety of fine arts disciplines, including the Dallas Museum of Art, the Winspear Opera House and the Meyerson Symphony Center. Additionally, the district offers a range of outdoor spaces to hang out and enjoy nature in the midst of downtown Dallas.

**PEROT MUSEUM OF NATURE AND SCIENCE** – The Perot Museum of Nature and Science serves as the city's gateway to scientific wonder.
